Disbursements

All disbursement fees are charged at cost.</p> <p>BAO Oversight Fee</p> <p>A fee charged by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario on every death registered within the Province of Ontario</p>
<p>Coroner's Certificate For Cremation</p> <p>A fee set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario for the issuing of a certificate that allows cremation to take place.</p>
<p>Municipal Death Registration Fee</p> <p>A fee set by individual municipalities to register the death.</p>
<p>Church Honorarium</p> <p>This is an amount paid to the church for the use of their facilities. In some cases it includes the services of the clergy as well.</p>
<p>Clergy Honorarium</p> <p>This is an amount paid to the clergy or person who facilitates the service or ceremony.</p>
<p>Church Organist/Soloist Honorarium</p> <p>This is an amount paid to musicians/performers for their services. In most circumstances this is a fee set by the individual musicians/performers.</p>
<p>Newspaper Death Announcement</p> <p>These are charges for death announcements placed in newspapers as a notification of the death and any pertinent details of visitation and/or ceremony. Fees may be charged on a per line basis and are set by the individual newspapers.</p>
<p>Cremation Fee</p> <p>The fee is charged by the crematorium for the cremation of the body. Fees vary by crematorium</p>

THREE STEPS TO FUNERAL PRE-PLANNING

Often times what you think will be best for your family will actually make things harder for them at the time. The plans you make will affect how they cope and come to terms with their loss.

Get Organized: The next step is to get organized by meeting with a Funeral Professional in your home or at their office. They are trained to help you evaluate the options available and will help you develop a plan that makes sense for you and your family.

Paying for the Arrangements: The funeral will have to be paid for eventually. The question is: pay now or have someone else pay later? Only you can decide that based on your financial status. Most people decide to pre-pay to make things easier for their families. There are numerous options for pre-payment. Your Funeral Professional will walk you through these options so you can determine what works best for you. If you choose to pre-pay, your Funeral Professional will draw up a contract itemizing the costs and payment terms.
